

The Committee this year has done a wonderful job. They are Peter Byrne, Toby Morrell, Jacqui Hughes, Sharon Kidd, Chris Holding, Kat Salisbury, Steve Willis, Andy Paton, Danielle Barter, Stewart O'Connor and Damien Slattery. The great part of this Committee has been that everyone takes on a particular responsibility but that they are also prepared to help out on all fronts. You have been a fantastic group to work with and have positively added to our club. We are always looking for others to join who want to work for the improvement of our children's sport.

This year we added Team Managers to all teams. I believe this has been very successful. I would like to thank all of them for stepping up with the duties of running the team. Our Coaches are also wonderful people and we were in the great position of having so many returning Coaches which meant a very smooth start to the year. We always ensure that we offer training for the Coaches and Team Managers to do their jobs. I do believe we are the only Club that offer all Coaches (free) Level One accreditation. We are in the fortunate position of having two Level Two Coaches in Peter and Toby who work with Coaches and players during the year.

We had over 140 Junior players registered this year – we went from having 9 teams last season to 12 teams this season, so we are steadily growing. We had several teams reach finals and several only just miss out. The improvement across all teams is a treat to see. The players are having fun and continue to develop their skills.

Stewart O'Connor and Serena Spadaro took over from Kat and Luke Salisbury with the In2Cricket and Dylan Sarolea and Brodie Dowen stepped up for the T20 Blast. Due to the increase in player numbers, we moved to Kingsbridge, where we could fit the 160 players who registered for these entry-level programmes. It was great to see the continuing family atmosphere on a Friday evening - even though the weather this year was quite challenging at times. We are looking at having a more rapid transition between In2Cricket and T20 Blast as well as between T20 Blast and Under 10's as we believe some players would benefit from moving through the programme a little quicker. Special congratulations to Stewart O'Connor on his award from the WACA for being the In2Cricket Coordinator of the Year for the Northern Region (that's everything north of the Swan River!). A well-deserved recognition.

We have been fortunate to have had new Committee members take on new roles. To Chris Holding with Fundraising, Andy Paton with Equipment and Steve Willis with Sponsorship - you have helped put the Club in a very strong position, in terms of both equipment and finances.

The work that Sharon Kidd and Danielle Barter did with Registration and collection of fees was fantastic. We had all fees paid very early in the year which allowed us to have financial direction for the Club. Thank you everyone for getting the fees in so very promptly. I don't believe too many Clubs would have the record we had this year.

This year we had our first McGrath Foundation 'Pink Stumps High Tea'. What a success that was! Congratulations to Kat Salisbury and Sharon Kidd for their amazing organisation which raised over \$1800 for a very worthy cause. Plans are already underway for next year. It is amazing what can happen with champagne and competitive spirits! Thank you to all those who participated.

We have also had many Juniors regularly playing in the Senior cricket teams. I would like to thank our Senior Liaison (and Senior Club President) Damien Slattery, for helping to make this happen, as well as Senior Club Chairman of Selectors, Mark Campbell. I would like to congratulate the Senior Club on their terrific season - to get 5 out of their 6 sides into finals (and the two top grades into the Grand Final) is a fantastic effort.

We are currently working with the Shire and the WACA for the development of cricket in the region. Our Club is growing but we need to ensure that we have the infrastructure that is critical to our success as a community-based Club. We are striving to put effective processes in place that can be easily handed over from one Committee to the next, to make sure the Club continues to move forward each year.

This is the 30th Season for our Club and what changes have occurred in that time! I would like to thank all those involved over those 30 years - it is due to their combined efforts that we originated, survived and flourished. We are now a club the WACA looks to and for assistance with growth in the Northern Region.

Again I would like to thank all those who volunteered this season - without your efforts we would not have a Club. A very special thank you to Peter and Toby - they are terrific people and they are the driving force for the Club and its future. I look forward to seeing you at the AGM on the 7^{th} June and in the 2016/17 season.

Sometimes it's being there to see the first time that a player reaches retirement and their reaction when they walk off to the applause of teammates and parents. If you didn't know, you would have thought it was a hundred as the kids are waving their bats and saluting the crowd! It is great to watch and it is why we are all here.

To all of the Coaches and Team Managers - you have done an outstanding job and should be congratulated for the time you have put in and what you have achieved this year. Without your efforts, we would not have the boys and girls playing cricket. Roll on next year!

I encourage the boys to continue to think like this.

I would like to mention one moment that I found special, and I hope he doesn't mind me saying it here. In one game, Charlie got out for a duck, and walked off the field. As he took his helmet off, I thought he would be mad, but he was smiling?? He had a good laugh at the situation, didn't let it affect him at all - he just talked through in detail what went wrong and what he would do to fix it for next time. This is a lifelong mindset we all need to hold on to! Have a great break and keep up the training for next year boys!


Gordon Watson Award
