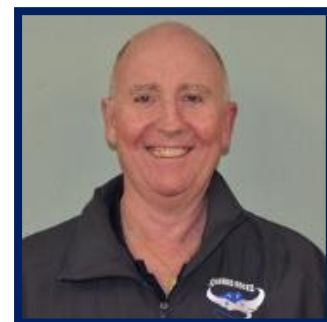

Our season started off with a few new faces to the team, some playing their first year of cricket, some into their 4th year. This year the boys decided on having 1 captain all year. This year with the boys losing their wickets and having to walk, we set about working hard on our defensive batting and playing with a straight bat on anything on the wickets and working hard to always bat our innings out. The work the boys put in definitely showed with the team only being bowled out twice all year and that was predominately from giving too many catching opportunities. There were some great highlights in our batting this year. Lots of retirements and some great supporting roles to those scoring well. Some worthy mentions are Aiden Young hitting his first ever four, Lewis Morrell belting his first six for the year, Tom Bailey in his first year of cricket facing 53 balls not out and then retiring! The speed at which Will Hardman and Zac Scott would run between wickets was great to watch every time the pair got to bat together. It was impressive to watch as every one of the boys managed to retire at least once this year. Some great improvement in shot play was seen by Riley Searson and some good consistent runs made by Blake Platt. Jordan Kalejs put some fear into many a bowler with his incredible clubbing of balls to all parts of the ground. We also saw some great consistency from Hayden Cable all year. We can't go past our batting report without mentioning Kai Orr's Captain's Knock of 109 off just 62 balls with an incredible 15 4's and 3 6's against Kingsley-Woodvale, supported by Tom as mentioned above. As this goes to press, Kai is 1 game off reaching 2 years of club cricket without losing his wicket. An incredible effort for a talented young cricketer.

The bowling has also been something the boys worked hard on this year with the challenge set to bowl everything on the stumps. Although we had some off days, the boys bowled incredibly well this year and took many of their wickets by not focusing on pace but simply just bowling it on the stumps. This made it hard for teams to put any reasonable scores together. Great efforts were seen by many of the boys, some taking their first ever wickets. Noteworthy performances were Will Hardman with an incredible 4 overs at 3 for 7 followed up next game with 5 overs at 3 for 22. Zac Scott's 4 overs at 2 for 12 and Kai Orr with an incredible 2 innings match performance of 4 overs at 6 for 5! Lewis Morrell managed to turn a few as well and have batsman unable to score off his bowling with season figures of 24 overs for just 35 runs! Sabtain bowling straight all year with 23 overs at 3 for 54 and we could always rely on Riley Hedley to produce some tight lines and knock the bails off when asked to do so, finishing up so far this year with 24 overs at 11 for 59 with 4 maidens.

We also had some great fielding displays with not much getting through our fieldsmen. Some great displays of wicket keeping were shown by Riley Searson and Will Hardman not letting many byes go past their gloves. Special mention to Liam Morley and his great fielding from deep fine leg and third man, consistently hitting the stumps from the boundary. The boys trained hard every session and always finished with catching and this showed throughout our games this year with some great catches taken, worthy of any classic catches reel!

The highlight for the whole year for me as a Coach was a game against KWJCC where fielding first we had our backs against the wall at 1/99 of just 18 overs. We came off for a drinks break with the boys heads dropped and feeling pretty ordinary. After a quick chat and regroup and some focus on what we wanted to do as a team, and reminding them it was going to require everyone to lift, we took an incredible 9 for 60 off the next 20 overs and went into bat with some confidence, which saw Tom's 53 ball retirement and Kai's 109 runs.

I would also like to give huge thanks to Sarah Hedley for managing this year and dealing with all the paperwork. Huge pat on the back to our parent group - you always made yourself available when it was your turn on the roster. Massive thanks to Jason Orr for setting out the boundary every weekend. To Toby and the Club, your support has been great and advice was always readily available. Finally this year, I need to thank Callum Morrell from our Under 17's for volunteering to help out as an Assistant Coach. 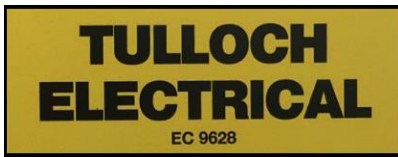

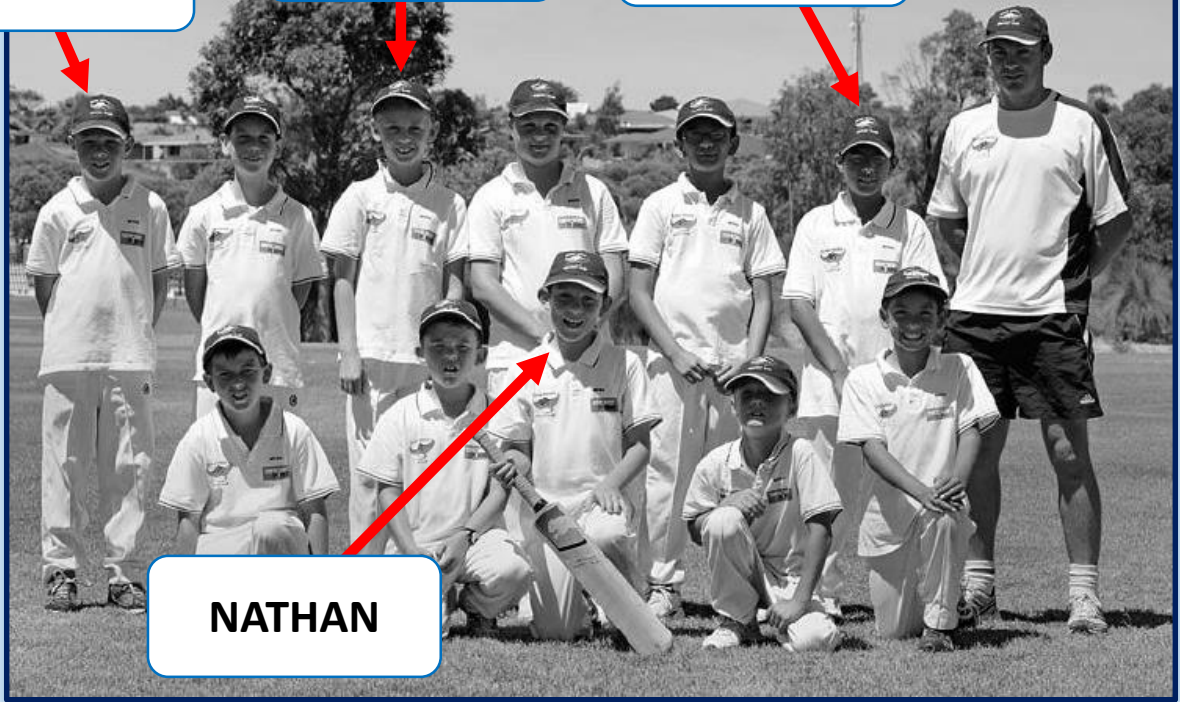

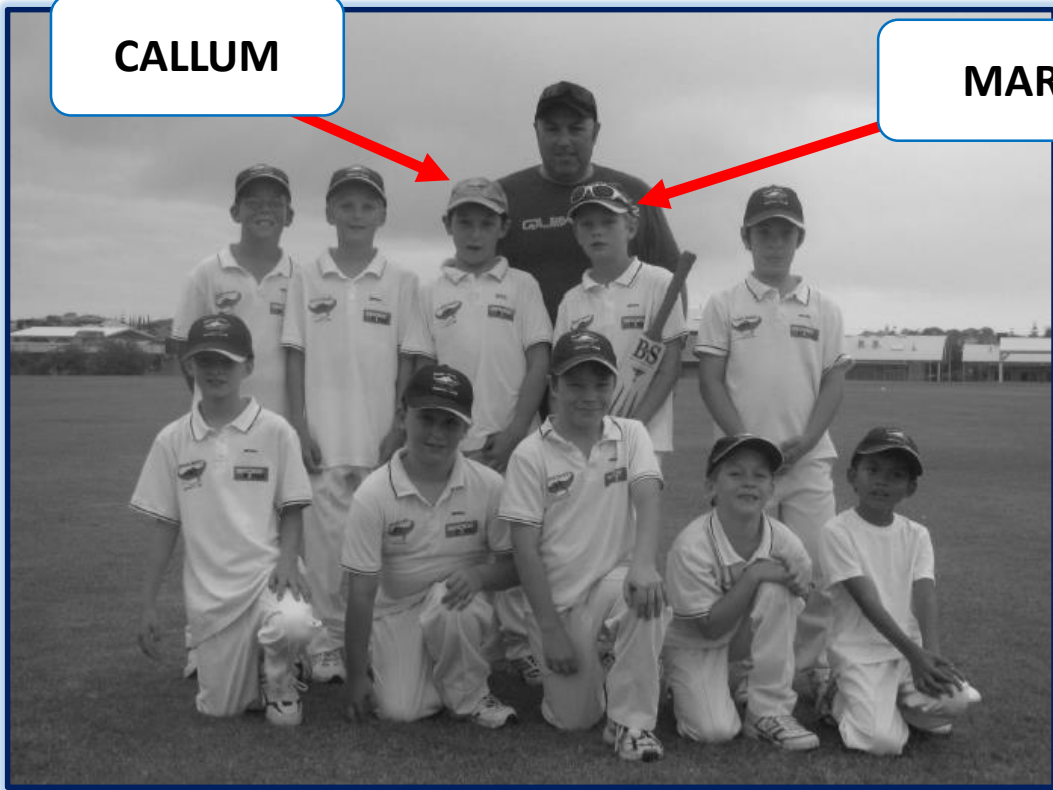
