What a fantastic year the Club has had!






Well with a few new faces to the team this year, our challenge was to gel as a team. With skill levels varying from State Level, District Cricketers to boys who had never played cricket before, we were always going to have a challenge ahead of us to compete in the top division which was where we were graded after our first One Day Games, and, after last year's undefeated season probably, where we needed to be. Although our results didn't show it in the win/loss scheme of things, I think this was one of the boys' better seasons for development of their game sense and also skill levels. The boys I believe were probably the best fielding/ bowling side in the competition albeit with a few hiccups early on. They were always alive in the field and maintained some great bowling. Fielding was always exciting to watch as they kept batsmen on their toes. Our batting definitely let us down with far too many times not batting out our 50 overs, which is critical to have a chance of securing a win.

There were definitely huge improvements by all players or special moments for each that shine through. Kai was again voted in as Captain and Lewis as his Deputy. They were in charge of all field placements and decisions out on the field. Towards the end of year Kai was challenged with creating the batting lineups and the order of our bowling spells. His success showed in our batting line up for the last game where we posted our highest score and had several retire not out. Lewis this year excelled out in the field and really led from the front when it came to keeping the chat up and keeping everyone on the job at hand. Aiden and Hayden really showed huge improvement in their batting, with great shot selection and their bowling improvement was drastically better with great line and length by both. My highlight with Jordan was I think him finally realizing that not all balls need to be hit like a golf ball and this saw him play some great offside shots this year. Zac again excelled with consistent bowling and willingness to chase any ball from any part of the oval with a number of return throws, direct hits. Mitchell definitely left his best for the last game, after being caught out a number of times this year skying some balls, I challenged him to hit every ball along the ground and see how he goes - 52 rtno was the result, his first half century for the Club. This year saw Sabtain try some spin bowling at training as opposed to his normal inswing deliveries. With the ball turning beautifully it took me two weeks to convince him to try spin in a match and to his delight took a wicket with his first delivery and never looked back. Riley H again showed his ability to knock the stumps over with beautiful straight deliveries with his consistency the big improver this year. Riley S showed some huge improvement in his bowling this year changing up his run in and putting some pace on it. Special mention has to go to the most unfortunate 1 handed classic catch taken by Riley that left his mates stunned that he took it only for the umpire to call No Ball. Will showed huge improvement with the bat this year after lacking some confidence early on - his shot selections were second-to-none towards the end of year. Tom's highlight (although I think he would like to forget half of it) was his return from breaking his thumb after tripping over running between wickets. He must have definitely put in some net time with the bat during his 6 weeks off with him retiring not out in our last game after hitting his first boundaries. Which leaves us with Andrew, our newest member, and in his first year of playing cricket. I believe he had more retired not out than any other batsmen, with his sheer determination to defend at all costs and just get bat on ball frustrating many a bowler. 

Quinns Rocks Scoops Pool At CJCC Awards

Quinns Rocks Junior Cricket Club was last night recognised as a leader amongst its peers, collecting three awards at the Community Junior Cricket Council presentations night at the WACA Ground.

About 200 people, including WACA CEO Ms Christina Matthews, Alcohol. Think Again Western Warriors Jason Behrendorff and David Moody and Western Fury player Bhavi Devchand, were on-hand for the Boundary Room function to acknowledge key volunteers, school ambassadors, players and clubs, with Quinns Rocks hailed for its proactive approach to growing the game.

The Club collected the prestigious Len Pavy Club of the Year Award, along with the Growing Cricket for Girls Award, following a year of strong activity and results in the area. Quinns Rocks had no girls-only teams competing in the 2016-17 season, but fielded two a year later.

The new pathway opportunities provided by the club added to the exceptional support Quinns Rocks showed to other clubs in its area, taking a collaborative approach to help grow the game.

Quinns Rocks' Stewart O'Connor was also named MILO T20 Blast Club Coordinator of the Year, having won the MILO in2CRICKET Coordinator of the Year award last year.

Community Junior Cricket Council Chair Geoff Parkinson said Quinns Rocks had been acknowledged for taking a proactive approach across a wide range of areas.

"Quinns Rocks has been very active in promoting the game within the community," Parkinson said. "The club has also fostered relationships with newly established clubs in their area to support their development, along with clubs in other regions as they look to forge relationships and share resources, which works to the mutual benefit of community cricket. They've also developed links with a number of schools, they're working with the WACA in developing an Aboriginal cricket pathway option and also had involvement in the Coach Development pilot program that has been established by the WACA, Cricket Australia and the Australian Sports Commission."
