

Gordon Watson Award

The junior club champion award was re-named the Gordon Watson during the 2008/09 season and is in recognition of Gordon's achievements and his wonderful service to cricket. It is awarded to the player who receives the most points over the season. This is worked out with every run awarded one point, every wicket awarded 12.5 points, every catch awarded 10 points, every "direct hit" run-out awarded 10 points, assisted run outs awarded 5 points and every stumping awarded 10 points. This is calculated at the end of the season and awarded to the player with the highest points over the season (teams are under 13's to under 16's included).

Here is a brief summary on Gordon Watson and what he has achieved throughout his wonderful service to cricket.

Gordon's interest to cricket began as a scorer in 1950/1 as there wasn't a junior's team. However, he started playing in 1951/2 with the Wickepin Cricket Club. He played 8 seasons there (3 as Captain) until 1960. He was also club delegate for 2 seasons.

In 1952 he captained the Junior Country week side - Wickepin/Narrogin.

He was with the Wickepin Association from 1954 to 1960, played 7 country weeks (3 as captain, 1957, 58, 59) and was Association delegate for 3 years.

He was with the Kondinin Club from 1960 – 1966 – 5 seasons (1 as captain). He was Club President for 3 seasons (1962/3, 1963/64 and 1964/5)

In 1961/2 was selected in the Eastern Districts Combined side against the Western Australian State side.

Played for City Beach in the M.C.A. for 4 seasons (2 as Captain) 1983/84 to 86/87 Best batting average in the 1984/85 season. Became Life Member in 1985/86

Played for W.A.C.A. Vets Subiaco-Floreat for 9 seasons, 1978 to 1985/86. Received batting award 1977/78 - 99no (highest score)

Gordon was on the Protest and Disputes Board for Perth Mercantile Association for 1 year in 1986/87

Coached the Joondalup Districts Inverarity Shield team for 1 year in 2003/4

Gordan has also coached the Quinns Rocks Junior cricketers from 2001/02 to 2006/07 (inclusive).

He has run the nets for the Quinns Rocks Seniors from 2007/08 to the current date.

Under 10s Quinns Coach's Report

What a fantastic season our under 10's have had & at the time of writing this, still have 2 games to go. We began the season with 6 players from last year's side and 6 players who had come through the ranks from in2 cricket.

In my five years of coaching cricket, it has been one of the best combinations I have ever had the pleasure of coaching. The combination of "the old, with the new" worked so well. The "old" players from last year's side smashed their performances from last year, making more runs, taking more wickets & holding more catches. For the "new" players they have seen the standard that the "old" players have set & rose to that level within minimal time.

Our lowest score for the season was 6 for 91 of 22 overs. Only twice did the boys score below 100 runs. Our highest score was 4 for 142 of 18 overs (around 8 runs an over) & also 4 for 148 of 24 overs. The boys have never lost 10 wickets whilst batting, they valued their wicket even though they were there to face their 12 balls each, regardless of what happens.

Individual efforts this season have been outstanding. 6 players have scored over 100 runs for the season, they are Nathan Clayton, Dylan Rasheed, Blake Fletcher, Reegan Wilson, Ryan Waldron & Seth Adams. Dylan Rasheed scored 52 runs in 2 innings (24 & 28 respectively), Nathan Clayton scored the first six (in round 1) & leads the way with 5 sixes for the season. Jack Dullard has gone the entire season without getting out. Connor Muir is our leading wicket taker with 12 wickets, but there are a few players just behind him.

I would like to take this opportunity to firstly thank the parents for their help with the scoring & square leg duties, Craig Wilson for all of his help at training & game days, & of course our players from Quinns Under 10's, you have made coaching very enjoyable. We have had a lot of laughs & a lot of fun throughout the season & to see the individual & team efforts that each & every one of you have produced & achieved is outstanding. To have gone the entire season without losing a game is a credit to you all & shows how much effort you have all put in to your cricket & how much you have all enjoyed it. Well done boys.
