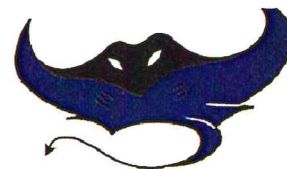


QUINNS ROCKS CRICKET CLUB JUNIOR YEAR BOOK 2013/2014

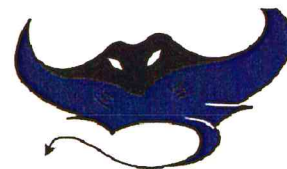
The Brian O'Connor Award is given to a player who was 12 years old at some point in the season and best displays the attributes of Brian and sets an example for others to follow.

GORDON WATSON AWARD

The junior club champion award was re-named the Gordon Watson Award during the 2008/09 season and is in recognition of Gordon's achievements and his wonderful service to cricket. It is awarded to the player who receives the most points over the season. This is worked out with every run awarded one point, every wicket awarded 12.5 points, every catch awarded 10 points, every "direct hit" run-out awarded 10 points, assisted run outs awarded 5 points and every stumping awarded 10 points. This is calculated at the end of the season and awarded to the player with the highest points over the season.

DISTRICT CRICKET

District cricket is the next representative level for junior cricket. For Quinns Rocks CC, the feeder district club is Joondalup District Cricket Club. Places are eagerly sought after and highly valued. Joondalup has two teams in each age division- Joondalup and Centurions. Some of our club's players also represent other district teams.

For U/13 and U/14, seven matches are played against other districts north of the river over the season. In the U/15 and U/17 competitions, twelve matches are played against north and south of the river districts sides.

Congratulations to Dylan Rasheed, Nathan Clayton, Tyron Hindmarsh, Ryan Ferguson, Callum Morrell, Kurt Hindmarsh and Nathan Alexandre (Joondalup), Matthew Oellermann (Claremont-Nedlands) and Scott Flannery (Wanneroo) on being selected for district cricket in 2013/2014.

At the end of each season, Joondalup districts selection trials are held at Illuka, from which training squads are chosen for the following season. Quinns Rocks CC wishes players that are selected to attend these trials all the best for selection in the districts teams for 2014/2015.

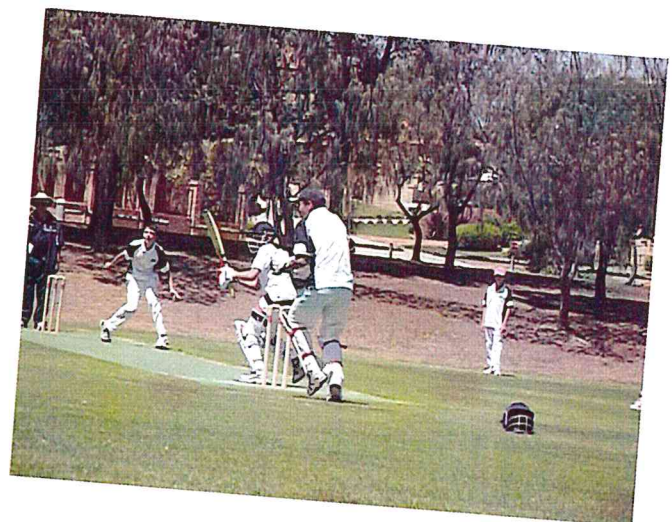
